Dear Jack,

I would like to take this opportunity to express our satisfaction on the installation of the WET-TECH *EnviroSaver II™* Ozone System for our wash room. As you know, we were quite skeptical about the promised savings and benefits so we had our 350 pound Washex hooked up for a lengthy trial run.
